
The Cooper School Careers Newsletter - March

All year groups will spend some time in the next few weeks logging on at school, and we encourage all parents and carers to spend some time with their children looking at this careers advice tool. It is really helpful with option choices at KS4 and KS5.



What is the Morrisby Test?

Morrisby uses a combination of psychometric assessments and questionnaires to give us an idea of where the student's strengths and preferences lie. After analysing the results, they offer impartial recommendations for careers and subjects that match your abilities and interests.

The assessments can assess your aptitudes, motivations, preferences and interests and match these to qualifications and careers which may suit you.


It provides innovative online tools to explore the career and educational choices suggested for you, allowing you to refine your choices over time so they remain relevant.

How to sign up:

Signing up in school or at home is really simple. Go to https://app.morrisby.com/account/signup, use your school email address and enter the School sign up code: MC88K15M.

After that you'll be asked to enter some basic information, and then you have an account. It take around 2-3 minutes!





What next after Year 11?

Although many of our Year 11 students have made their decisions about their future steps, we have dedicated careers advisers who are on hand to offer advice for all Y11s.

Over the next few weeks they will be meeting with Year 11 students to givemore guidance

on future steps. When a student has had a careers interview, they will be sent a Careers Plan.

Please make sure your child passes on the Careers Plan to you! Many students decide to continue their studies here at the Post 16 Centre where we offer a wide range of A Levels courses and some level 3
